The All India scholastic online chess championship is being organized by South Mumbai Chess Academy on a pan-India level since December 2020.

The 10th Edition of the Championship was a huge success with over 388 participants from all over India and even from countries like Hong Kong, the United Arab Emirates and Singapore.

The championship has seen growing popularity ever since the 1st Edition and we hope to see more in the coming years.





# Schedule of the Tournament

- The Tournament will be held on 23rd and 24th October 2021 on Tornelo.
- Last date to register is 21st October 2021.
- The duration of the game will be 15 min+ 10 secs each.
- There will be total 7 rounds.

# Prizes

# Prizes



Top 3 winners shall receive trophy, medal and e-certificate and scholarships as follows:

- 1 Hour of One on One Game Analysis Session with SMCA's professional coaches for free (worth Rs 1500/-)
- 2 Free Tickets for participating in SMCA Live's Sunday Chess Tournament (Held every Sunday. This scholarship cannot be redeemed in the Inter-School Tournament). (Worth Rs 1,000/-)
- 3 Hours of Group Sessions conducted on Saturdays. (Scheduled by SMCA) The scholarships should be redeemed within 2 months.



# Prizes



- The 1st rank holders of the age group shall receive all the above-mentioned prizes and scholarships along with a gift voucher worth Rs. 1000/-
- The trophies and medals will be sent either by courier to the winners or they can collect it from SMCA Centres or our Corporate Office in Mumbai.





# Criteria for Participation

- Age Criteria for participation is between 5 yrs - 16 yrs.
- There will be separate categories for Boys and Girls.
- Each category will have the following 6 sub-categories:
  1. Under-6 (Born on or after 1st Jan 2015)
  2. Under-8 (Born on or after 1st Jan 2013)
  3. Under-10 (Born on or after 1st Jan 2011)
  4. Under-12 (Born on or after 1st Jan 2009)
  5. Under-14 (Born on or after 1st Jan 2007)
  6. Under-16 (Born on or after 1st Jan 2005)

# Rules and Regulations

- Participants are requested to enter their correct fide id and rating in the registration form. In case of wrong information being found by the arbiters, the arbiter may disqualify the participant for the round and change the results of all the past games played, if required.
- The maximum duration of the a game shall be around 30-45 minutes. Participants are expected to keep their zoom mic, camera and screen share on until their game is on. Arbiter has complete authority to disqualify the participant who fails to do so. 1 warning shall be given.
- Player's tornelo.com, zoom and registration username should be same.



# Rules and Regulations

- Presence of the participant on [tornelo.com](https://www.tornelo.com) and zoom is mandatory.
- Participants should have access to windows computer/laptops with a good internet connection
- Participants using Mac computer/laptops should mandatorily use side camera (connect zoom from additional device) which should cover their hands and laptop screen visibility
- The time shall be controlled by an online chess clock, no time shall be added if the participants fail to join the round late nor the game shall be restarted. Thus, participants are requested to be active 15 minutes before the start of the first round



# Rules and Regulations

- Participants under the age of 6 are requested to keep an additional camera on as they would require additional tech support.
- Arbiter has the authority to ask any participant playing on top boards for set up of a side angle camera. Participants are suggested to keep their speaker volume not less than 20% to be able to listen to the arbiter's guidelines and requests.
- On day 2 of the tournament i.e., Sunday, participants of the top 5 boards across all age groups will have to mandatorily share side angle camera for all 3 rounds of the last day. The list of participants playing on top 5 boards shall be shared in their WhatsApp groups on Saturday.



# Rules and Regulations

- This is an official chess tournament conducted by the team of FIDE as well as international arbiters. Any misconduct or cheating caught during the tournament shall be communicated across all association of chess.
- Demo of the tournament shall be conducted on the first day of the tournament at 9 am sharp. Participants who do not wish to join the demo round, kindly join at 9:45am sharp for the first round

***The event is been handled by an expert team of National, International, FIDE Arbiters. Arbiter's decision shall be final. Organisers will not interfere with the decision of the arbiters.***

# Right to Protest



- The right to protest is given to the participants to allow them to raise their concerns if they feel that their opponent has cheated or the arbiter's decision was not correct for their game according to the participant.
- To raise the protest officially kindly mail [smca.tournament@gmail.com](mailto:smca.tournament@gmail.com) with the complete details including the age group, round number, board number, and opponent's name. You are suggested to write about the incident briefly.
- To raise the protest, kindly gpay Rs. 2000 as protest fees to 9821493956 (Balaji Guttula, SMCA) and share the payment screenshot in the same protest mail, the protest has to be done within 15 mins of end of the round. No protests post the stipulated time shall be entertained. This is because of the pairings that are scheduled as per the points earned in the previous rounds
- If the protest was successful and the opponent is found cheating, you shall receive the points as well as Rs 2000 as refund.
- If not then we shall retain Rs. 1000/- and only refund Rs. 1000/- back
- No other mode of communication shall be accepted for protesting.
